

DIRECTIONS FROM YUNGABURRA

Park car in town – in Main Street or somewhere near the Park. Ride along Gillies Highway towards Atherton. Make sure you stop at Petersen Creek to spot the platypus. Cross bridge on the pedestrian path and then turn left up the Curtain Fig Tree Road. This is uphill so suggest you ride single file stopping at the Fig Tree for a rest and a good look around the tree. When you are ready, continue uphill a short distance and on your right you will follow Coleman Road which is a gravel and grass pathway. Down the hill almost to the farm house Coleman Road continues through the gate. Follow this track until another gate. Be sure you leave gates as you find them and, if chained, ensure the chain is hooked properly. At the end of the gravel track, you will turn right into McKeown Road which you then follow back to Gillies Highway. Be careful! Here you cross, turn right and immediately turn left into Pinnacle Pocket Road. You are now half way so have a rest and quench your thirst. Follow Pinnacle Pocket Road down to and along the old Kulara Road (The original Kulara township is now under Lake Tinaroo) turning right into Thomas Road. A reasonable hill to tackle then in the rainforest turn left into Davis Road. Down the hill then right into Denny Road South. Follow Denny Road South around to the left and enter the gate. Continue along the grass until you pass through the gate on the edge of the rainforest. Follow the trail down through the rainforest and cross Petersen Creek. It is worth taking time here to explore the Petersen Creek walking tracks and view platypus, find tree kangaroos, cross the swing bridge, sight the old ram pump and water wheel. Note all this area has been re-vegetated and is maintained by volunteers. If you find a donation box please drop in a coin or two so that this work can continue. If you follow the cycle trail you will arrive at Mulgrave Road, turn right then through the round- about . Yungaburra town centre is directly ahead. Hopefully you can find your car! Relax and enjoy a coffee with extras at one of the popular coffee shops.

Estimated time 1.5hrs with a few rest stops.

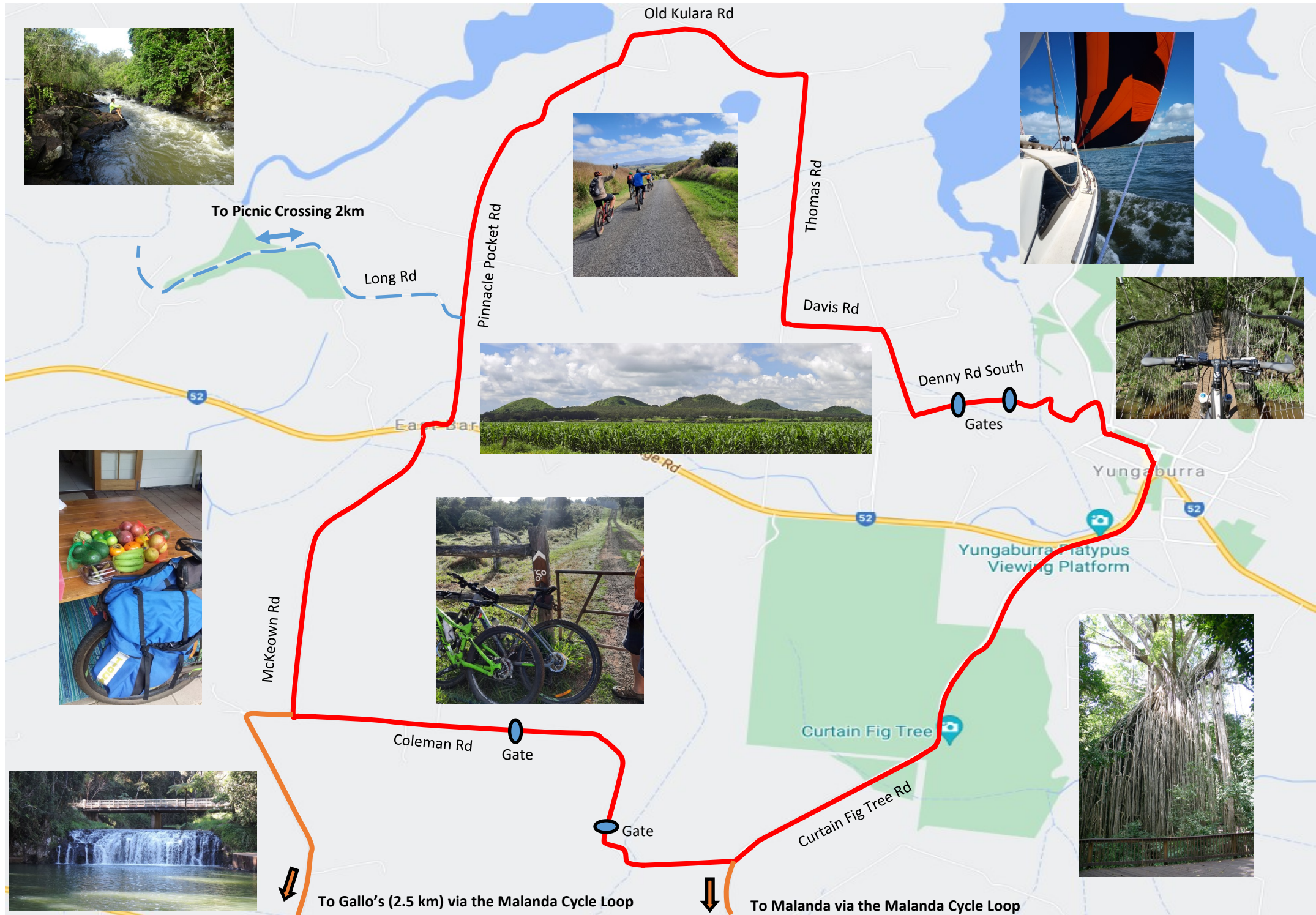
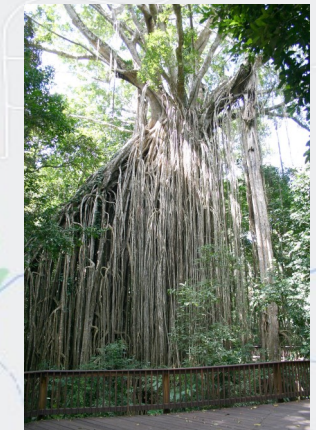
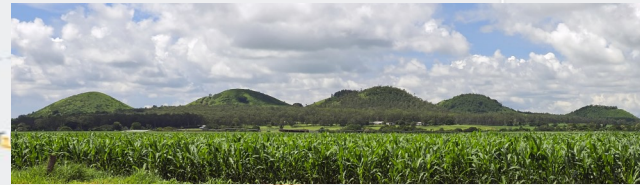
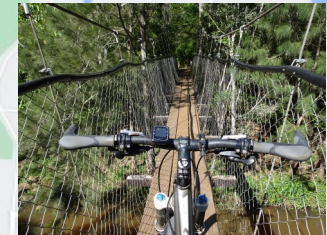
